Construction Updates

On Friday, August 4, we successfully completed the safe delivery and installation of our largest piece of process equipment at our Rochester Hub refining facility. This equipment has a height of 85 feet, a diameter of 19 feet, and weighs more than 230,000 pounds. The equipment was ordered approximately 20 months ago, reflecting our strategic approach of planning well ahead to ensure smooth construction timelines.

This was part of a larger delivery, which included a total of five large pieces of equipment totaling over 450,000 pounds. The equipment arrived by barge at offloading point on the Genesee River and were then transported 6.3 miles to the Rochester Hub project site.

The equipment helps concentrate specific solutions by evaporating water, leaving behind a valuable product for further processing to recover critical battery materials.

In close collaboration with the Town of Greece, City of Rochester, Monroe County, NY State Police, Frontier Communications, Rochester Gas & Electric (RG&E), Veolia North America, Li-Cycle's project team and contractors, we closely coordinated efforts for the secure transportation of the equipment.

As construction continues to ramp up at the Rochester Hub site, there may be slower than usual traffic along Ridgeway Avenue, Lake Avenue, and Mount Read Blvd. We assure you that we will make every effort to minimize any inconvenience caused and sincerely appreciate your patience during this period.

We're happy to report that we've completed construction of the Hub's warehouse, which will serve as a central office space for our employees. As we continue to grow our team, and as construction activity increases, there may be an uptick in traffic on Ridgeway Avenue. This workforce expansion will continue throughout the year, as we expect over 500 temporary construction workers involved in the Hub's development.
